WHEREAS: The only time a charter can be lifted is at the pre-convention DEC meeting; and

WHEREAS: These charters are then sent to the National American Legion; and

WHEREAS: The National American Legion can send these charters back if the revitalization program has not been followed; and

WHEREAS: This process becomes cumbersome and dual paperwork; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That The American Legion, Department of Pennsylvania Executive Committee meeting in regular session January 8-10, 2010 at the Holiday Inn, Moon Township, PA hereby require the District Commanders to start immediately and every January hence forth to receive from the Department Membership Supervisor a list of those posts who fall below the 15 and 35 membership requirements; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the District Commander will record on the form provided to them the time, date, action taken and all other manners to show an effort was made to revitalize the post before the pre-convention DEC meeting held at the Department Convention in July.
